Henry Winkler's portrayal of "The Fonz" for 10 seasons on *Happy Days*, made him one of the most recognized actors in the world. He won two consecutive Golden Globe Awards and three Emmy nominations.

In 2003, Winkler began writing a series of children's novels with his co-author, Lin Oliver. The books are inspired by Winkler's struggle throughout his education due to his learning challenges and the books have appeared on several best seller lists.

He also remains busy as an actor and producer. He served as Executive Producer for "Hollywood Squares", "MacGyver", "Dead Man's Gun", "Sightings", and the Disney series "So Weird".

Under his own production company, Winkler created numerous projects geared for a young audience.

Winkler's film and television credits include "The Water Boy", "Scream", "Down to You", "Nightshift", "Holes", Fox's highly acclaimed series "Arrested Development", NBC's "Third Watch", NBC's "Law & Order: Special Victims Unit", and ABC's "The Practice" for which he received an Emmy nomination. He is also the voice of Norville the Bird on the Award Winning animated children's series "Clifford: The Puppy Years".

In 2001, Winkler starred on Broadway in Neil Simon's "The Dinner Party" marking his return to the Broadway stage after an absence of 30 years.

Winkler has used his high visibility and position to help others, particularly children through many groups and associations, resulting in even more awards and recognition.
